NOTICE TO MARINERS

LAKE LOTHING – OULTON RAILWAY BRIDGE – NEW LIGHTS ESTABLISHED

Mariners and Port-Users are advised that new Navigation lights have been established to mark the Navigable channel transiting from Lake Lothing to Mutford Lock entrance under the Oulton Railway Bridge.

The lights characteristics and positions are as follows:

Bridge Centre Span East	Iso White 10s	52° 28.464'N	01° 42.760'E
Bridge Centre Span West	Iso White 10s	52° 28.466'N	01° 42.753'E
Bridge Channel North Side	FIG 2.5s	52° 28.467'N	01° 42.763'E
Bridge Channel South Side	FIR 2.5s	52° 28.462'N	01° 42.759'E

The lights are solar powered and the Channel port and starboard lights are visible from either side of the Bridge approach when within the Navigational channel.
