Once received your application will be posted on our notice board for a period of four weeks, after which it will be presented for consideration at the next committee meeting.

The Lowestoft Cruising Club is not a commercial marina and not a place to simply berth a boat. The ethos of the club is one of self-help and the facilities and social activities that we enjoy at the Cruising Club have all come as a result of our members personal efforts. From engineering & painting to catering & legal services, our members are expected to participate where they can, be it a working party, social function or an AGM.

You too may be asked to contribute some of your time, effort and skill, if required. If you feel that all you want to do is berth your boat on our moorings or if you don't think you can afford the time to help with the upkeep and/or social activities of the club, then this is probably not the right club for you.

With respect to berth allocations:

Please be aware that because there is great demand for long-term berths at our moorings, we operate a waiting list system. Usually, the waiting list is quite long and one can expect to wait several years before arriving at the top of the list. The Moorings Officer is able to advise on the current availability of both short- and long-term berths.

Note: Permanent berths are only available to Single or Family members, not Crew members.

Membership types

There are three types of membership:

Single Membership

One person over the age of 18

Family Membership

Two adults living together, with or without children under the age of 18

Crew Membership

Only available for the personal crew of existing boat owning members

Fees

Joining Fee

£200.00 (Non-refundable)

Family Membership

£50.00 per year

Single Membership

£40.00 per year

Crew Membership

£35.00 per year (no Joining Fee is required)

Proposer and Seconder

The proposer must offer a written/emailed submission to the committee in favour of the applicant and we would draw your attention to the Club's Constitution paragraph 3.3:

"No adult member may propose or second a candidate for membership unless they are currently and have beenfully paid-up members of the club for the two years preceding the date of application.

Should either the proposer or the seconder be committee members, it is expected that they attend the meeting at which the proposal will be discussed.

Data Protection

Membership of the Club implies acceptance of the Constitution and the Rules of the Club by the member and will be deemed to constitute consent to the Club holding relevant personal data for the purpose of the Data Protection Act (2018) and the General Data Protection Regulations made thereunder.
