### Applicant seeking membership

Once received your application will be “posted” on our notice board for a period of four weeks after which it will be presented for consideration at the next committee meeting.

The Lowestoft Cruising Club is not a commercial marina and not a place to simply berth a boat. The ethos of the club is one of self-help and the facilities and social activities that we enjoy at the Cruising Club have all come as a result of our members personal efforts. From engineering & painting to catering & legal services, our members are expected to participate where they can, be it a working party, social function, or an AGM.

You too may be asked to contribute some of your time, effort and skill, if required. If you feel that all you want to do is berth your boat on our moorings or if you don't think you can afford the time to help with the upkeep or social activities of the club, then this is probably not the right club for you.

With respect to berth allocations, please be aware that because there is great demand for long term berths at our moorings, we operate a waiting list system. At the moment the waiting list is quite long and one can expect to wait several years before arriving at the top of the list. Our [Moorings Officer](#) is able to advise on the current availability of both short and long term berths at our moorings.

Note: Permanent berths are only available to Single or Family members, not Crew members.

### Membership types *There are three types of membership:*

Single Membership	One person over the age of 18.
Family Membership	Two adults living together with or without children under the age of 18.
Crew Membership	Only available for the personal crew of existing boat owning members.

Joining Fee	£100.00 (Non-refundable)
Site Development Fund	£100.00 (Payable on joining but refunded on resigning from the club)
Annual Single Membership	£30.00
Annual Family Membership	£35.00
Crew Membership	£30.00 (No Joining Fee or Site Development Fund loan is required for this type of limited membership)

If either the proposer or the seconder are committee members it is expected that they will attend the meeting at which the proposal will be discussed.
