## **Application notes**

#### Applicant seeking membership

In order that your application can be processed, please complete the form as fully as possible. Once completed, either print it off and hand it to your proposer or email it to membership@lowestoftcruisingclub.co.uk.

Once received, you will be contacted by a committee member and invited to meet with committee members at the club and to be shown round the club facilities. This will be your opportunity to ask any questions you may have and we will be able to find out more about what you can bring to the club in return. Your details will then be posted on our notice board for a period of four weeks, after which time your proposer will submit a written submission in support of your application and will be considered at the next committee meeting. Your proposer must be a current, fully paid up member and have been a fully paid up member for two years preceding your application date.

The Lowestoft Cruising Club is not a commercial marina and not a place simply to berth a boat. The ethos of the club is one of self-help. The facilities and social activities that we enjoy at the Cruising Club have all come as a result of our members' personal efforts. From engineering and construction to administration and organising social events, members are expected to participate wherever they can.

You too may be expected to contribute some of your time, effort and skill to support the club. If you feel that all you want to do is berth your boat on our moorings and are not prepared to help out with the running of the club, then this is probably not the right club for you.

Becoming a member does not automatically allow you to berth your boat the club. We currently operate a waiting list for moorings and when there is great demand, it can take a few years to get to the top of the list. Should you wish to enquire about mooring your boat at the club, please contact the club Moorings Officer, who will be pleased to advise you regarding the availability of berths.
